**EXTRAORDINARY JUBILEE OF MERCY**  
**Dec. 8, 2015 – Nov. 20, 2016**

It is Pope Francis' hope that we will apply the medicine of mercy, a concept put forward by Pope St. John XXIII, toward those in our parish, especially those who feel they are not loved or who have struggled to be faithful. The purpose of the Jubilee, one might say, is to help us all learn again about God's endless mercy – but also to learn and practice our own call to be people of mercy – a **Church of Mercy**.

The Logo for the Year, which features Jesus -- the Good Shepherd -- taking "upon his shoulders the lost soul, demonstrates that it is the love of Christ that brings to completion the mystery of his incarnation culminating in redemption. " The image, created by Jesuit Father Marko Rupnik, also shows one of Jesus' eyes merged with the man's to show how "Christ sees with the eyes of Adam, and Adam with the eyes of Christ." The motto, Merciful like the Father (Luke 6:36) serves as an invitation to follow the merciful example of the Father who asks us not to judge or condemn but to forgive and to give love and forgiveness without measure. It is an image quite important to the early Church: that of the Son having taken upon His shoulders the lost soul, demonstrating that it is Christ's love that brings to completion the mystery of His incarnation culminating in redemption. The logo has been designed in such a way so as to express the profound way in which the Good Shepherd touches the flesh of humanity and does so with a love that has the power to change one's life. The scene is enclosed in a mandorla, an element typical of ancient and medieval iconography that recalls the coexistence of the two natures, divine and human, in Christ. The three concentric ovals, with colors progressively lighter as we move outward, suggest the movement of Christ Who carries humanity out of the darkness of sin and death. Conversely, the depth of the darker color suggests the impenetrability of the love of the Father Who forgives all.

## PRAYER

### SUNDAY READINGS SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

#### First Reading: Jeremiah 23:1-6

In this passage, God denounces false leaders who have scattered his people. He promises that they will be reunited and led by one who is just and wise.

#### Second Reading: Ephesians 2:13-18

Paul explains that through Jesus Christ, there is no longer hostility between Gentile and Jew. Instead, through the Spirit of Christ, both groups become one body and are equal in the eyes of God.

#### Gospel: Mark 6:30-34

The apostles returned after their first mission and told Jesus what they had done and taught. He told them to rest, but the people kept coming to them. So they went to find a private place, but the people learned where they were going and arrived first. Jesus felt sorry for them and decided to teach them instead of resting.

### CHRISTIAN FORMATION

#### Registering for Religious Education in the academic year 2015-2016

Christian Faith Formation is our program for grades Kindergarten-8<sup>th</sup>. Incoming sixth graders all move into our Junior High Program. If you have a child going into high school you should be receiving information from Youth Ministry- the Confirmation Program, whose Director is Ms. Anne Marie Gisoldi. Their registration and payment is separate from ours. For new families interested in registering, please contact us for a program brochure with your education options. All currently enrolled families should have received their re-registration forms in the mail by now and we ask that you please return them promptly. To sign up for one of the options we ask that you carefully consider which option best suits the way your child learns and what is best for the family as a whole. Remember space sometimes can be limited in certain programming so we urge you to return your completed paperwork in a timely fashion.

If you have a child in preschool, please contact us to learn more about the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Program. If your child has special needs, we also can share with you about our God's Rainbow program. One great way to evangelize and spread the word about the love of Jesus is to invite others to come to know Him.



Evangelio San Marcos 6, 30-34
