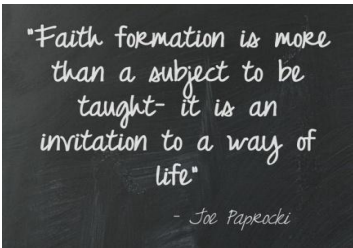
The weekend collection for Saturday/Sunday, August 13/14 amounted to \$20,120.00. Your generosity to our Church is gratefully appreciated.

Once all the finishing touches are in place we will set a date and time to bless this wonderful step into the future of Saint Vincent Martyr School. An Opportunity To Do Something

So many of us were deeply moved by the image of five year old Omran Dagneesh who was rescued a week ago Wednesday after an airstrike in Syria. His picture appeared in social media across the globe, in television news stories and on the front page of many newspapers, including the New York Times. Anne Barnard from the Times wrote this: "...he sits alone, a small boy coated with gray dust and encrusted with blood. His little feet barely extend beyond his seat. He stares, bewildered, shocked and above all, weary ..." How do we help Omran and the great number of children who suffer the effects of war and civil unrest? Each of us must ponder that question. The answer is far from easy but must begin with owning the truth that these children are our younger brothers and sisters and that we are their keepers - we are responsible for their well being. While we may not be in a position to take little Omran into our care we can ask ourselves what our attitude may be to taking into the care of our community refugees that are seeking a new beginning in our great country. I was recently approached by one of our parishioners with the following piece for our parish bulletin. I ask you to read it, and think about it and pray about it in the context of thoughts I share with you here. Thanks.

TWO 2-BEDROOM APARTMENTS NEEDED IN MORRIS COUNTY

Two Middle-Eastern Refugee families will be arriving here in early fall and will need housing. The families are being sponsored by Church World Service (CWS) and Refugee Assistance Morris Partners (RAMP), a coalition of 24 local religious organizations committed to supporting and assisting them. Each apartment should accommodate a family of 4 - 6 people including children. Apartments must be affordable, in the \$1,200 - \$1,500 per month range, have a one-year minimum lease, and be located near public transportation and shopping.
