#### Ministry Overview:

- 4 years old with approximately 20 participating parishioners (including a number of new participants coming from the stewardship drive) and staff and students at SVMS;
- Activities consist of visits / events at the VA hospital in Lyons, hosting veterans in Madison, or supply drives;

#### Spring has been busy for the ministry:

- The parish and school donated approximately \$5000 in toiletries and arts and craft supplies over Memorial Day;
- SVMS hosted veterans from the local VA nursing home to a concert, coffee and reading of thank you compositions in May;
- In June, teams of parishioners have twice hosted and supplied refreshments for evening music events on the VA campus;

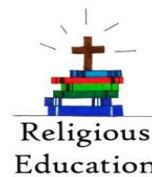

Experiencia Hispana

XIV Domingo del Tiempo  
Ordinario

**Primera Lectura: Zac. 9, 9-10**

A continuación escucharemos un trozo del libro del profeta Zacarías. La situación histórica de este texto nos resulta desconocida. Probablemente fue escrito a finales del siglo cuarto o comienzo del tercero antes de Cristo. El profeta invita al pueblo a la alegría. Se le anuncia una noticia alegre y esperanzadora: la llegada de un rey justo y victorioso. El nuevo rey humilde y pacífico es garantía de un futuro de paz y de justicia.

**Segunda Lectura: Rom 8, 9. 11-13**

Durante cinco domingos estaremos escuchando fragmentos del capítulo 8 de la carta de san Pablo a los romanos, dedicado a la vida del cristiano en el Espíritu. Para el apóstol hay dos maneras de existir: "en la carne", dominados por los instintos y pasiones egoístas, o "en el Espíritu", vivificados y guiados por Dios. Este espíritu ha resucitado a Cristo; hemos sido bautizados, por tanto, unidos a Cristo y su espíritu habita en nosotros; somos así hombres nuevos.

**Evangelio: San Mateo 11, 25-30**

La perícopa evangélica de este domingo la hemos estructurado en tres partes:

- 1) acción de gracias al Padre por la revelación recibida;
- 2) contenido de dicha revelación y
- 3) invitación y llamada. Presten mucha atención a este impactante mensaje, pero antes entonemos el aleluya.

**Tiempo Ordinario**

Después de una extensa preparación de nuestras vidas en el tiempo de Cuaresma para recibir al Mesías, salvador del mundo, regresamos al tiempo ordinario, donde la Iglesia Católica se viste de verde. El Tiempo Ordinario está conformado por 33 domingos y domingo 34 celebramos la fiesta de Cristo Rey del Universo. Durante este gran tiempo, reflexionaremos el ministerio de Cristo en este mundo, acatando y practicando lo aprendido por el Señor Jesús a través de sus enseñanzas. En este tiempo, reflexionamos que el Señor está con nosotros y que su ejercicio sacerdotal se continúa en la Iglesia a través de la Liturgia.

Vivamos con fervor con uno de estos domingos de este Tiempo Ordinario, para que el Señor Jesús entre en nuestras vidas y nos ayude a prepararnos para el encuentro con Él.
